



BC Club Challenge Playoffs

For the **2016-17 season**, we will be holding a separate playoff weekend to determine our club's representatives for the BC Club Challenge (Traveller's Championship). We will have 1 Men's team and 1 Ladies' Team represent our club.

The date for our club event will be **February 25-26, 2017**. Teams must sign up by **January 30th, 2017** to take part. The playoff format will be dependent on the number of teams that sign up.

The winner of our Campbell River BC Club Challenge playoff must be willing and able to represent the club at higher competition levels including:

- North Island Club Challenge hosted by the Comox Valley Curling Club (dates TBD, generally at the end of March 2017), and
- Pacific International Cup / BC Club Challenge April 19-23, 2017

Eligibility:

- Any men's or ladies' team that plays together regularly in a Club League.
- 1 spare is allowed and they must play lead.

Costs:

Teams must understand the financial and time commitment that these competitions require. The Club will pay for your entry fee to the North Island Club Challenge. The North Island Region will pay for your entry to the BC Club Challenge (Richmond). All other expenses will be the responsibility of the curlers.



Ladies' Club Playoffs 2016-2017

The ranking of teams will be determined by:

- 1) Total points
- 2) Head-to-head (who beat who, in case of tie)
- 3) Tie-breaker playoff game(s)

Ladies Club Playoffs will take place **Monday March 20th to Wednesday March 22nd, 2017.**

- Tie-Breakers – Monday March 20th, 2017 at 6pm
- Semi-finals on Tuesday March 21st at 6pm
 - 1st vs 2nd (Wednesday League)
 - 1st vs 2nd (Thursday League)
- Finals (winners of semi-finals) – Wednesday March 22nd, 2017 at 6pm

Playoff games will be 8 ends. 1st place teams get choice of hammer or rocks in the 1st end of the semi-finals. Coin toss for hammer in the final game.



Men's Club Playoffs 2016-2017

- The top two teams from Tuesday night league
- The top three teams from Wednesday night league
- The top two teams from Thursday night league
- One wild card team
(A total of 8 teams will qualify)

The wild card team will be the team from all three leagues with the most points in their final 18 games only. Meaning that the first three games played on the Tuesday and Wednesday night leagues will not be counted for the wild card position only. The reason for this is that the Thursday night league teams only played 18 games during the season and all other teams played 21 games.

The ranking of the teams will be determined by;

- 1) Total points in each league except the wild card spot
- 2) Head to head (who beat who, in the case of a tie)
- 3) Tie breaker playoff game(s)
- 4) In the case of a tie or tie's for the wild card team or team's it is possible that a coin toss will determine the winner.

Playoffs will be held the week of **March 20th, 2017**
