### Wind Up Spiel     March 17th

Please note that the deadline for entry into this event is March 9<sup>th</sup>. The draw master will have the list of what time your first game posted on March 10<sup>th</sup>. The entry fee is \$35 for curling and the meal, \$25 for extra meal tickets.

### AGM

The AGM will follow immediately after the supper and presentations. If folks are coming for the AGM only, you must arrive by 6 pm when the registration numbers will be dispensed.

### Discussion for the meeting

The Board members have received many complaints this season about the games that are dragging on long past the acceptable 2 hours. These concerns have been also been echoed by the club management. In order to discuss this issue, there will be a motion made at the AGM that we adopt using the buzzer system to ensure that games are completed in a timely manner. The buzzer system is when a buzzer is sounded at a designated time each game. When the buzzer sounds the teams will complete the end that they are currently playing and play one more ends (max 8) with no exceptions. After the motion is made there will be time for discussion regarding the problem and the possible solutions. The Board feels that the most viable solution is to adopt the buzzer system. Another option is to implement 6 end games. There may be other suggestions that come from the floor that can be explored. Once the discussion is concluded there will be a vote to support or defeat the motion. If the motion is defeated there is an opportunity for a second motion to be made. If no acceptable resolution is made the matter will be presented to the Campbell River Curling Club Board of Directors. Please give this matter some thought prior to the AGM.

### REGISTRATION

This is a reminder that pre registration for next fall will take place immediately following the AGM. We are trying to streamline the process this year by having numbers assigned to members, then randomly drawn. There will be small groups chosen in each batch so that there are only a few folks signing up at a time. There will be a separate table for each of the leagues: Tuesday & Thursday AM/PM and well as the Wednesday PM and /spare list. People will have the chance to register themselves and their spouse as well as registering 2 absentees. The absentees will be listed on a separate list to be slotted in by the draw master after the live registration is completed.
